Check-in is at the Arcadia office for all weekday and Sunday departures. Check-in at the Arcadia office for all day trips. Check in at the Arcadia office for all overnight trips *except* when told to go to Gardner for the 19.5 mile/Zolfo Springs to Gardner. You check in at Arcadia, we take you upriver and you canoe back to Arcadia. If doing the *19.5 mile* starting on a weekday, during slow season, or on a Sunday, you check in at Arcadia, load your gear on the bus in Arcadia, then follow the bus to Gardner to park your vehicle or arrange for a pick-up or be let out of the gate. When in doubt, come to Arcadia first.

From Tampa Area:

I-75 south to Exit 217 (State Rd. 70). Take 70 east about 37 miles to western outskirts of Arcadia. Look for the Peace River Campground on the left. Turn left/north onto County Road 661, which is also the road to Ona and the Road Prison. CR 661 runs along the west side of the campground, along the metal fence. Canoe Outpost is the next parking lot on the right just behind the campground. Watch for the canoe mailbox and the blue & white buses. **Approx. travel time from Tamp: 1 ½ -2 hours**

From St. Petersburg/Clearwater Area:

Take 275 south over Skyway to I-75. I-75 south to Exit 217 (State Rd. 70). Take 70 east about 37 miles to western outskirts of Arcadia. Look for the Peace River Campground on the left. Turn left/north onto County Road 661, which is also the road to Ona and the Road Prison. CR 661 runs along the west side of the campground, along the metal fence. Canoe Outpost is the next parking lot on the right just behind the campground. Watch for the canoe mailbox and the blue & white buses. **Approx. travel time from St. Pete/Clearwater: 1 ½ -2 hours**
