From Orlando Area:

I-4 west to U.S. 27. U.S. 27 south to Avon Park. Turn right onto Highway 64. Take 64 west about 23 miles to Zolfo Springs. In Zolfo Springs turn left at the first traffic light onto US 17. Go south on 17 about 10 miles to the community of Gardner. Once past the golf course on the left, watch for River Road which is a dirt road, on the right just around the bend in the road. Turn right onto the dirt road. Signs read River Road SW and Peace River Public Boat Landing. Follow dirt road about 1.5 miles to gate with the canoe. Turn left through gate and follow the shell drive. If you miss the gate, turn around at the boat ramp.

Approximate Travel Time: 2 hrs.

From Lakeland:

Take 98 south to State Rd. 60. Turn left. Follow 60 east to US 17, turn right. US 17 south through Fort Meade, Bowling Green, and Wauchula to Zolfo Springs. Go south on 17 about 10 miles to the community of Gardner. Once past the golf course on the left, watch for River Road which is a dirt road, on the right just around the bend in the road. Turn right onto the dirt road. Signs read River Road SW and Peace River Public Boat Landing. Follow dirt road about 1.5 miles to gate with the canoe. Turn left through gate and follow the shell drive. If you miss the gate, turn around at the boat ramp.

Approximate Travel Time: 1 ½ hours

From Winter Haven:

US 17 south through Fort Meade, Bowling Green, and Wauchula to Zolfo Springs. Go south on 17 about 10 miles to the community of Gardner. Once past the golf course on the left, watch for River Road which is a dirt road, on the right just around the bend in the road. Turn right onto the dirt road. Signs read River Road SW and Peace River Public Boat Landing. Follow dirt road about 1.5 miles to gate with the canoe. Turn left through gate and follow the shell drive. If you miss the gate, turn around at the boat ramp.

Approximate Travel Time: 1 hour

All reservations, day & half-day trips, weekday overnight, and off-season overnight trips are handled through the main office in Arcadia. Note: The Gardner office is only open during spring and fall for overnight check-in. All overnight canoe trips require reservations made in advance with the Arcadia office, **863-494-1215 or 1-800-268-0083**. To avoid mix-ups, please call ahead to verify which office you need to check-in at. Customer vehicles for all trips ending in Gardner on either Saturday or Sunday park in Gardner year 'round. We can also arrange weekday/end of trip parking in Gardner for groups (no pick-up required).
