Outfitted canoes are **\$150.00*** per canoe for two people for one night and two days. Extra person in middle under 12 is free, over 12 is \$10.00* per day. Each extra night is \$50.00* per outfitted canoe. * Add 7 % State Sales Taxes. Prices subject to change without notice.

Remember to bring plenty of food and drink (also see list below). Also see the Canoe Outpost-Peace River Overnight Helpful Hints for more information.

Every canoe in a group does not need to be outfitted, usually every other one. We suggest the rental of separate tents, sleeping bags etc. Example: four people usually only need one stove and one lantern.

At Check-in, customer needs to determine if they will need the Outpost cooler w/ ice or just the ice. The cooler and/or ice are given to customer at time of check-in.

All gear is in campbox, except water, sleeping bags, and cooler. All Canoe Outpost outfitted gear will be placed on bus and in canoe by staff with the exception of the cooler. All Canoe Outpost outfitted gear is in the campbox with the exception of the sleeping bags and the water jug. Sleeping bags are double-bagged.

Make sure all personal gear is labeled and double bagged in plastic bags or in water-resistant containers.

Please do not eat or store food in tent. Ants will chew through floor and walls of tent.

A credit card hold is required for each outfitted canoe. A \$50.00 service fee will be charged against the card if cancellation of the outfitting is not given by 4:30 p.m. of the day prior to trip. Each outfitted canoe should handle their own credit card hold or can be put on the group leader's card. Service fee is charged regardless if a canoe is rented or not. **Credit Card Authorization Form must be signed and returned (either by e-mail, mail or fax) to Canoe Outpost one day prior to scheduled paddle trip.** Credit card hold will also be held for 14 working days after day of trip to allow for inspection and cleaning of gear. Any damages will be assessed and charged to the credit card. After 14 days the card hold will be destroyed.

Items provided by Canoe Outpost

Dome tent (8'x8' base, 3 adults comfy)
Cooler with one bag of ice
2 sleeping bags
Propane stove w/ propane tank
Propane lantern w/ propane tank

Dish towel, dish cloth, dish soap
Scouring pad
Iron skillet
Can opener
Plasticware (8 forks, 8 spoons, 8 knives)
Serving spoon, fork, and spatula
Garbage bag
Water (2.5 gallons)
Wee-Wee Kit (towel, sm. roll of toilet paper)
Bucket

Suggested items to be brought by customer

Sunscreen, sunglasses, hats
Bug repellent
Extra cooler for drinks (saves ice for food)
Sheets for warm weather, blankets for cold
Grill
Flashlight (for inside tent)
Rope (clothesline if needed)
Paper plates cups, & towels (less to wash)
First Aid kit
Raingear
Lawn chairs
Charcoal and starter/firewood
Towels, washrags, personal toiletries
Extra flatware (less to wash)
Sharp knife
Extra garbage bags
Change of shoes (Dry shoes for camp)
Toilet paper
Seatbacks (stadium seats) or can be rented

Don't forget books, magazines, playing cards, Frisbee, fishing poles, sketch pad, camera, fossil sifters, and board games for leisure time while at camp. 10/29/10
